- Step 1: Referral to Dean—Warning/Phone Call to Parent
- Step 2: Referral to Dean—Dean's Lunch Detention
- Step 3: Referral to Dean—Double Dean's Lunch Detention
- Step 4: Referral to Dean—Saturday School
- Step 5: ISS—Positive Work Experience
- Step 6: Suspension

Tardies:

- Step 1: Warning/Parent Phone Call Home
- Step 2: Teacher Detention
- Step 3: Referral to Dean—Dean's Lunch Detention
- Step 4: Saturday School
- Step 5: ISS—Positive Work Experience
- Step 6: Suspension

Minor Offenses in the Classroom:

- Step 1: Warning/Parent Phone Call Home
- Step 2: Teacher Detention
- Step 3: Referral to Dean—Dean's Lunch Detention
- Step 4: Saturday School
- Step 5: ISS—Positive Work Experience
- Step 6: Suspension

Electronic Devices:

- Step 1: Referral to Dean—Warning/Parent Pick-Up
 - Step 2: Referral to Dean—Saturday School/Parent Pick-Up
 - Step 3: Referral to Dean—ISS—Positive Work Experience/Parent Pick-Up
 - Step 4: Referral to Dean—Suspension/Parent Pick-Up
- Refusal to give cell phone to teacher, staff, or administrator—Suspension*
- *Electronic Devices brought to the Dean's office by teacher only
 - *Parent Pick-Up 3:30-4:00 the day of the infraction, or the following day(s)

AHS Dress Code Guidelines

2015-2016

Head Gear

- No hats, curlers, or bandanas
- No hair colors that are distracting in class

Accessories

- Clothing, jewelry, and accessories cannot have any vulgar, profane, violence/death oriented, gothic, gang related, sexually suggestive, or promote alcohol, drugs, or tobacco.
- Piercings shall be limited to the ears ONLY!
 - You must have a neutral spacer for all other piercings.

Upper Garments

- Sleeveless garments must be at least 1.5 inches in width
- Cannot reveal under garments or expose your chest
- Cannot reveal midriff
- NO tube tops, halter tops, racerbacks, or spaghetti straps

Lower Garments

- Pants shall be worn at the waist
- Shorts must have a sizeable inseam and may not expose buttocks
- Minimal holes/rips—cannot expose undergarments
- Dresses and skirts must reach mid-thigh
- NO Pajamas
