



7th Grade Supplies and Expectations

Follow them for a successful year!

1. Use the following format to head all of your papers:

Last Name, First Name
Subject, Period
Date
Title (centered)

2. Expect an average of 1½ hours of homework each week night.
Homework will vary from subject to subject and from student to student.
3. Arrive at class on time with the required materials.
4. To start the year, please have:

GENERAL ITEMS:

- Textbooks (provided by school (on the first day)
- Paper grocery bags for book covers
no sticky book covers (even the ones that leave no residue)
- One 2-inch, 3-ring notebook to hold materials and daily supplies
(listed below)
- One box of tissues (collected in Math)
- Three glue sticks (collected in LA/SS)
- One box of colored pencils
- One roll of masking tape (collected in LA/SS)
- Your school planner (provided by school)
- Blue or black ball point pens
- #2 pencils – 24 pack
- Notebook paper (college ruled)
- Colored markers (small box)
- Highlighters (yellow, green, orange, and pink)
- One USB flash drive
- One small pair of scissors
- Notebook dividers



SPECIFIC CLASS REQUESTS:

LA/SS:

- 2 5 Star 5-subject spiral notebook (**8½ x 11**)
- Post-it-notes (1½ x 2)
- 3 x 5 note cards
- Red pen

PE / HEALTH:

- Change of active-wear: T-shirt and shorts with no buttons or zippers. Shorts need to be mid-thigh. Tennis shoes need to be laced and tied.
- Dedicated section in your 3-ring binder (Health)

MATH:



- Scientific calculator with fraction, percent, sin, cos, tan, etc. such as TI 30XA (a graphing calculator is not necessary at this level)
- Red ball point pens for correcting
- Two or three single-subject composition book (about 100 sheets – 9¾ x 7½)
- ¼ inch graph paper
- ruler

SCIENCE:

- One single-subject composition book (about 100 sheets – 9¾ x 7½)
- Dedicated section in your 3-ring binder
- Your math calculator

4. For safety reasons, no book bags/backpacks are allowed in classrooms, hallways, gym, or gym locker room during the school day. Keep them in your lockers and use them to carry materials to and from school only.
5. Use your planner in all classes by checking the board, notes binder, or wall chart the first day of the week or the beginning of each period. Your teachers will explain the procedures you need to follow in their particular classes.
6. Keep all electronic items, if you choose to bring them, in your locker from 8:00 a.m. to 2:53 p.m. (cell phones, music devices, etc.)
