**Visiting the School**

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## Early Dismissal

- Make eye-contact down on her level.
- Look out for ear infections and treat them promptly.
- Pronounce words the way adults do so your child will know what is correct.
- Speak a little slower.
- Use funny voices when reading a story to interest your child.
- Ask your child to make a prediction about a story.
- Be a good listener to model for your child.
