Dear Parents/Guardians,

I am writing to inform you of a necessary, mass schedule change that may your child's teacher and/or schedule starting Tuesday, September 6th. As you know Brevard Public Schools must comply with the State of Florida's Class Size Amendment which requires high schools to have class size averages of no more than 25. Since we received more students than projected, many of our academic classes were well above this limitation. As a result, the district provided us with an additional teaching unit at the 6-day count meeting so that we could reduce our class sizes. This will allow your child to have the benefit of being in smaller classes. Schedule changes are effective immediately and are required to meet our district and state mandates. We are confident that this change will enhance your child's educational program and allow them more time for personalized instruction from their teacher. Tuesday, September 6th, you will have an opportunity to meet all of your child's teachers. Open House begins at in your child's 1st Block class. I would like to thank all of you for your patience and understanding as we begin another wonderful school year.

Our school has launched a new electronic flyer communication tool called "Peachjar." To view school-approved eflyers, simply click the Peachjar button on the school's website.

This "green" initiative will save our schools tons of paper and reduce copy costs by thousands of dollars. On top of that, posting school flyers in this electronic backpack removes a significant administrative burden from teachers, office staff, and volunteers.

No action is required on your part. You will receive a welcome email from our service provider (Peachjar) that includes a username and password. This is provided to give you the opportunity to manage your account and flyer delivery preferences. You do not need to login to receive or view school eflyers. To ensure smooth delivery of this communication, we suggest you add bpsflyers@peachjar.com to your email contacts. When you receive your first eflyer, be sure to click "always display images."
