Please return your Federal Impact Aid Survey Forms

Federal Impact Aid Survey Forms were sent home with students today. It is imperative that we receive one form per student completed and returned to school as quickly as possible. The data received from the surveys is used to provide funding for the Brevard County Educational Program. Brevard County Schools receives approximately \$1.5 million annually from Impact Aid from the Federal Government. These funds benefit all schools in the District. Federal Impact Aid Funds are distributed based on the number of students whose parents or guardians are engaged in some form of Federal Activity such as living on or working on federal property (like KSC) or residing in subsidized low rent housing.

In order to receive these funds, the school district must annually conduct a pupil-parent survey to validate the district's claim for Federal Impact Aid. Results of the survey are used to prorate the appropriated funds to approximately 1,300 qualifying districts nationwide. Your information is treated confidentially with only those persons assigned to compile and audit the information having access to the forms. Complete information about this is on the form. Thank you for your cooperation and assistance in helping to provide funding to our schools!

BMI Screenings are coming soon...

Attention parents of students in grades 1, 3 and 6: **Body Mass Index (BMI)** and scoliosis screenings are scheduled for the week of October 17th through the 21st for all students in grades 1, 3 and 6, unless the parent/guardian chose the “opt out” option at registration.

All information will be given to the *Department of Health* who will have staff generate reports for the parent/guardian. When the reports come back, parents/guardians will be given a two week window to either pick up their children’s reports or send a self-addressed stamped envelope to have the report/s mailed home. After the two weeks, any remaining reports will be sent home with students.
