BMI Screenings are coming soon...

Attention parents of students in grades 1, 3 and 6: **Body Mass Index (BMI)** and scoliosis screenings are scheduled for the week of October 17th through the 21st for all students in grades 1, 3 and 6, unless the parent/guardian chose the “opt out” option at registration.

All information will be given to the *Department of Health* who will have staff generate reports for the parent/guardian. When the reports come back, parents/guardians will be given a two week window to either pick up their children’s reports or send a self-addressed stamped envelope to have the report/s mailed home. After the two weeks, any remaining reports will be sent home with students. If you have any questions regarding this, please contact **Nurse Rina** in the Atlantis clinic, or Assistant Principal **Ms. Judson** at 633-6143.

Learn to Save a Life! Suicide Prevention Family Workshop

The training is a 2 hour interactive skills-based workshop that provides families with the opportunity to learn:

- How to identify suicide risk factors, warning signs and protective factors
- How to interact or communicate with youth who may be thinking about suicide
- How to build a safety net around youth in order to keep them safe.

A stipend will be provided for childcare and transportation (\$30) to each family.

At the end of the training, participants will be asked to take part in a 3-month follow-up survey. USF will contact participants and will pay them for the time (\$25).
