BMI Screenings are coming soon...

Attention parents of students in grades 1, 3 and 6: **Body Mass Index (BMI)** and scoliosis screenings are scheduled for the week of October 17th through the 21st for all students in grades 1, 3 and 6, unless the parent/guardian chose the "opt out" option at registration.

All information will be given to the *Department of Health* who will have staff generate reports for the parent/guardian. When the reports come back, parents/guardians will be given a two week window to either pick up their children's reports or send a self-addressed stamped envelope to have the report/s mailed home. After the two weeks, any remaining reports will be sent home with students.
