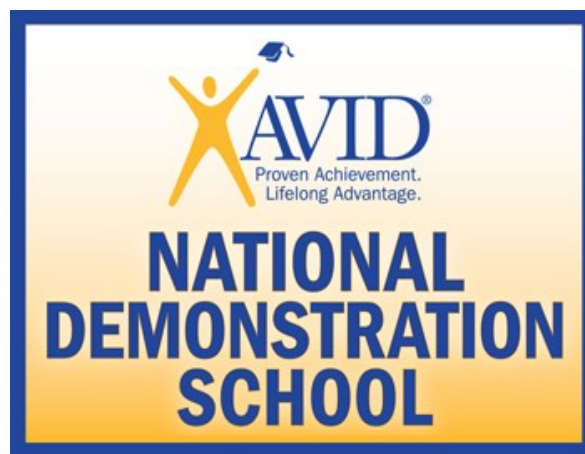

The PERT (Postsecondary Education Readiness Test) is being offered to students needing a passing score on the FSA Algebra 1 EOC, as a graduation requirement. Earning a PERT score of 97 or better is equivalent to a passing score on the FSA Algebra 1 EOC. The opportunity to take the PERT is available to a student, only after taking the FSA Algebra 1 EOC .

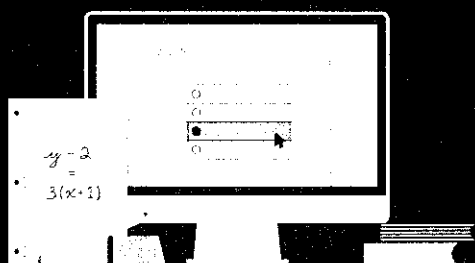

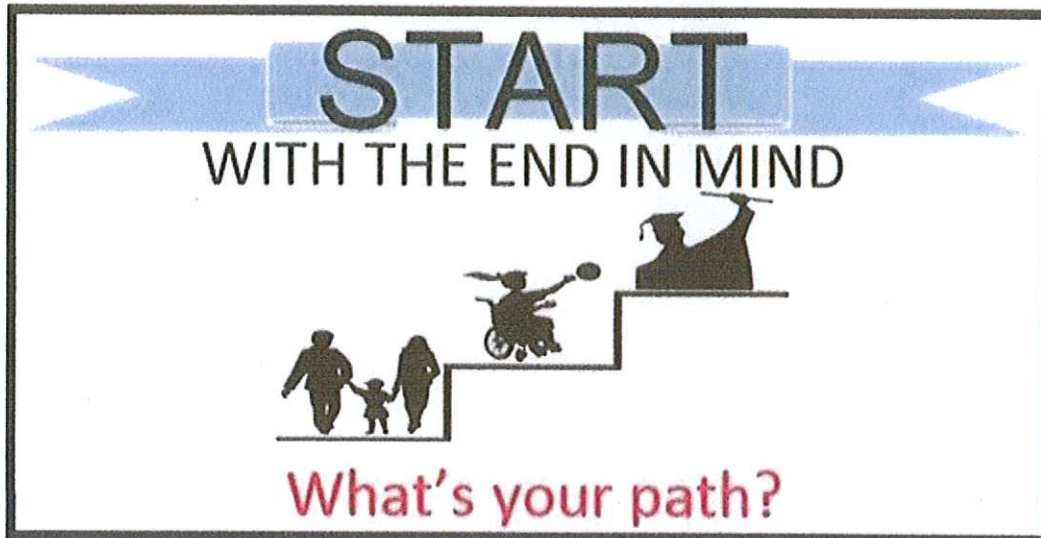
