Dear Sacred Heart Family:

The Spring Auction is quickly approaching - **Saturday, April 28, 2012**, beginning at 6:30 p.m. - and will be the major social event of the school year! Our goals for the Auction, the school's primary fundraiser, are to have 350 attendees and to raise \$55,000. To raise that much through a tuition increase would cost more than \$250 per student.

As a reminder, each school family is obligated to the following:

- **Each family is required to donate an item valued at a minimum of \$50.00.** This obligation, however, does not actually have to cost you \$50. You can:
  - donate a service (babysitting, baking, handyman, etc);
  - donate a homemade item (knit wear, jewelry, etc);
  - secure a business donation (your hairdresser, mechanic, favorite restaurant).

Alternatively, you can also satisfy your Family Donation Requirement by selling fifteen \$10 Raffle tickets (\$150); simply sell them to your family or friends!

Kindly fill out the enclosed Auction Donation Form and return it attention: Michele Bonham no later than March 12 to allow enough time for each item to be listed in the Auction Program. You should deliver your donation to the Parish Center on the day of the Auction, between 9:00 a.m. and 12:00 p.m., creatively packaged to encourage bidding. Feel free to join with other families to create baskets or donate a higher value item.

- **Each family is required to purchase (or sell) four admission tickets.** Admission Tickets are \$15 each. Upon request, you can also receive two complimentary tickets with your purchased tickets. Ticket Order Forms will be distributed in March. Ticket price includes Auction entrance (bidding number) and hors d'oeuvres. Cash bar will be available. Help us reach the attendance goal of 350 by inviting your friends and family to enjoy this evening! Guests do not have to spend a lot of money to help. If people spend just a few dollars at the Speakeasy bar, purchase a \$10 raffle ticket, or simply generate more bidding on the silent and live auction items, we would be able to reach our monetary goal. So, bring your friends, family and neighbors and enjoy an evening of "Wonderful Nonsense" at SHS Auction 2012: the Jazz Age!

As always, for any successful event, **we need volunteers**. Each year dedicated parent volunteers organize this fantastic event. Becoming involved in the Auction provides volunteers an opportunity to meet other Sacred Heart parents, develop friendships and contribute time and talents to a worthwhile endeavor. Please use the enclosed volunteer form to let us know how you would like to help.

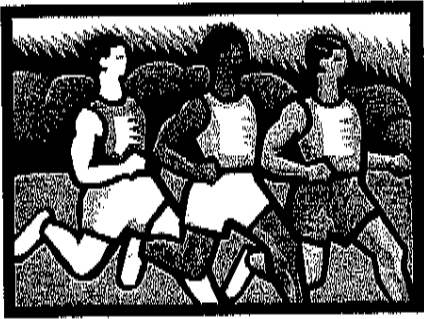

### Requirement to Participate

Skaters should be able to do a two foot glide on the ice at a minimum. If you're not sure whether your child can do this, please ask. Pre-hockey is for children under age 12. *Skating classes are available from Center Ice of DuPage Skating Academy and are strongly encouraged.*

### USA Hockey Membership

USA Hockey membership provides you with valuable information, a USA Hockey magazine subscription and, most importantly, additional insurance coverage at the rink. *Membership is free for players age 6 and under and \$43 for players age 7 and older. This is a **one-time annual expense** for all hockey players at all age levels, including coaches. **Membership is required for all pre-hockey participants after the first two free dates.** Prior to the first date of the session, you will be required to provide a printed copy of your child's USA Hockey registration receipt OR the registration number assigned to you. ### Minimum Equipment Needed

Hockey skates (rental available at rink), stick\*\*, helmet with face mask\*\*, gloves\*\*, hockey knee/shin guards and elbow pads are strongly recommended
