Class Size Information

I Read You Read

Solar Eclipse August 21st

An eclipse is a great learning opportunity for students and adults, but many may be unaware of the dangers. Even looking directly at a small part of the eclipse is too dangerous, as the normal squint response will not occur and the eye will be exposed to dangerous amounts of UV light. The cornea will focus the light and actually scorch the retina. There is no pain involved with retinal damage, which is worrisome. By the time the damage is done, it is too late.

The eclipse begins around 1:21PM and will continue until 4:17PM. Maximum viewing is approximately at 2:53PM. Please be sure your students are aware of the importance of not viewing the eclipse with the naked eye.
