I am so proud of our students and teachers for their hard work towards our school Grade of an “A” this year. We went from a “C” to an “A” with a gain of 107 pts. from last year. We held high expectations for our students and pushed them to do their personal best and they rose to the occasion soaring in both reading and math. In grades 3-5 reading and math, we EXCEEDED both district and state means scores. That is simply amazing! Also, we made gains in science going from 40 percent at proficiency to 70 percent of our students meeting proficiency. We also made big learning gains in reading (ELA) and with our lowest 25%. Congratulations to all! We will have a student recognition and “A” celebration at the end of this month.
