

Region and hub location stops, identified on the three regional busing maps, are in “draft” form at this time. Beginning March 30<sup>th</sup> through April 15<sup>th</sup> a regional bus survey will be available on the Family Dashboard of parent(s)/guardian(s) who applied for an Educational Program Opportunity (EPO). Completion of this survey is vital, as the information will determine interest and final location of stops.

Here is how Regional Busing will work:

A.M. – Parent(s)/guardian(s) will be responsible to ensure student is at designated hub or region bus stop for pick up. A Brevard Public School (BPS) bus will pick up the student(s) and transport to their EPO School.

P.M. – A BPS bus will pick up student(s) at their EPO School and transport student(s) to their A.M. hub or region bus stop. Parent(s)/guardian(s) is responsible to ensure student(s) departs safely to home.
