Discuss Croton Compact

Mrs. McDonough shared the Croton Compact. It is the same as last year's compact. She requested that the members review the compact and make any comments or changes necessary, then sign. This compact will be shown to parents during Open House to give them a chance to add or make suggestions. Mrs. Price inquired if the Compact needs to be posted in the school. The Title I teachers shared that compacts will be sent home with every student, once approved.

Review Parent Involvement Plan

Mrs. McDonough shared the Title I plan for parent involvement. The annual parent meeting is our open house. She shared the activities at our school that encourage strong parental involvement which include Cheers and Tears, Wow Science night, Reading, Math, and Writing night, and we use SynerVoice to keep parents informed. Staff Training includes the mentoring program, business partner training, SAC team training. Accessibility describes how we accommodate handicapped family members. It also includes posting the Parental Involvement Plan online as well as providing communication to parents in their native language. The board was encouraged to make comments or revisions to the plan, and then sign.

Review School Improvement Plan draft

Mrs. Price shared the current draft which is a work in progress. The data that we reviewed at our last SAC meeting will be added at a later date. She shared that Best Practices will include information about our PBS plan. This year we will focus on Tier II. This will help students who do not respond to the Tier I plan. This will also reduce the amount of problematic behaviors and increase student motivation. Programs will include "Check In/Check Out" program, as well as others. She discussed our Reading Goals which will include "Thinking Maps" this year.
