Submit your video entry by tweeting the video (or video link) to [@educationfl](#) or posting the video on the department's [Facebook page](#) by Wednesday, November 27, 2013. Remember, videos do not have to be professional quality.

Official Contest Rules

1. **ENTRY:** No purchase necessary to enter or win. Participants can enter by tweeting/posting videos (or video links) to the department's [Twitter](#) or [Facebook](#) pages.
2. **ELIGIBILITY:** This contest is open to all parents, grandparents and legal guardians of Florida K-12 students.
3. **WINNER SELECTION:** A selection committee will review each submission on its creativity, originality and adherence to contest theme to determine finalists. All decisions of the committee are final. Finalist videos will be posted on the department's [Facebook page](#) and the winning video will be determined by the number of "likes."
4. **PRIZES:** **The contest winner will receive a family four-pack of tickets to LEGOLAND and overnight hotel accommodations. Contest finalists will receive \$50 VISA gift cards.**
5. **WINNER NOTIFICATION:** Finalists will be notified within three business days after the contest closes. Inability to contact a finalist may result in disqualification and selection of an alternate finalist. The winner will be notified within three business days after voting closes.
6. **GENERAL CONDITIONS:** The video submitted must be the original work of the person submitting the video. The contestant grants the department a non-exclusive, perpetual, worldwide license to broadcast, publish, store, reproduce, distribute, syndicate, and otherwise use and exhibit the submission in all media now known and which may later come into being for purposes of trade or advertising without compensation.
7. **USE OF CONTEST INFORMATION:** All entries become the property of the Florida Department of Education and it reserves the right to use any and all information related to the contest.
8. **CONDUCT:** Upon submission of a video, all contest participants agree to be bound by these official rules.
