RE: 2012-13 School Public Accountability Reports (SPAR)

The 2012-13 Elementary and Secondary Education Act School Public Accountability Reports (ESEA SPARs) are now available. The SPARs meet the ESEA's requirement for schools and districts to provide parents with an annual school status report at the beginning of each year.

Rather than having you print a copy of the report for parents or the public to view, we are asking that each school **post a link to the SPAR report on the front page of its school website by October 31, 2013**. Please have the link clearly identified as "2012-13 ESEA School Public Accountability Report." Then, in your next newsletter or school-wide communication, please notify parents that the report is available and where it can be found.
