SUBJECT: VOLUNTARY STUDENT ACCIDENT INSURANCE 2012-13

The student accident insurance program for Brevard County Public Schools will continue to be administered by *School Insurance of Florida*, P.O. Box 784268, Winter Garden, FL 34778-4268, telephone number 1-800-432-6915. The Reliance Standard Life Insurance Company will underwrite the voluntary Student Accident Insurance program for 2012-13 school term.

The costs of the plans are as follows:

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| 1. <u>School Time Coverage Pre-K to 6th Grade \$10.00</u> | 4. <u>Senior High Football \$80.00</u> |
| 2. <u>School Time Coverage 7th to 12th Grade \$15.00</u> | 5. <u>Spring Football (only) \$25.00</u> |
| 3. <u>24 Hour Coverage \$48.00</u> | |

Or students may elect Enhanced Plan options:

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| 1. <u>School Time Coverage Pre-K to 6th Grade \$15.00</u> | 4. <u>Senior High Football \$150.00</u> |
| 2. <u>School Time Coverage 7th to 12th Grade \$28.00</u> | 5. <u>Spring Football (only) \$45.00</u> |
| 3. <u>24 Hour Coverage \$92.00</u> | |

School Insurance of Florida will ship enrollment materials by UPS directly to every school on **July 17th**. The material will likely arrive at your school on **Wednesday, July 18th or Thursday, July 19th**.

The material for high school football programs will be shipped on the same day to the athletic office. Please make certain that someone is available at your school to receive the shipments. The program does not require school staff to collect the insurance premiums; all enrollment forms and premiums are mailed directly to the servicing agent by the parents. Please be sure to read all the enrollment materials you receive, in order to familiarize yourself with the program.

It is important that this program be offered to all students attending your school, and especially students participating in interscholastic athletic programs. Please ensure that all students receive a brochure at the beginning of the school year. In addition, the same material should be given to all transfer students and new arrivals during the course of the school year.

Please remember that injuries to students participating in interscholastic football are not covered under the regular Student Accident Insurance Policy. These student athletes should elect to be covered under the appropriate special football policy. If students participating in interscholastic sports do not enroll in one of the Student Accident Insurance plans, they must provide a signed statement from their parents/guardians certifying that the student is covered under a major medical plan and they wish to waive the district offered plan.
